As the assault on reproductive rights intensifies globally, **SheDecides** remains unwavering in its mission to build a world where all women, girls, and young people can make decisions about their bodies, lives, and futures – without question.

In 2025, with regressive policies like the Global Gag Rule resurfacing, global cuts to Official Development Assistance (ODA), and a coordinated rise in misinformation by anti-choice groups, our **role as a leading global convener championing SRHR** became more urgent than ever. Working with SheDecides Champions and allies, we intensified efforts to keep SRHR firmly on the political agenda, working to strengthen the pro-choice community to resist rollbacks and advance rights.

► 2. Keeping SRHR on the Global Political Agenda:

In 2025, we focussed on ensuring our issues did not drop out of critical global discussions, driving visibility and action at key international policy forums.



► **CSW:** 
Co-partnered and moderated the **GSAD** session **“Advancing Abortion Rights and Access”** and co-convened a Ministerial luncheon with the **Governments of Colombia and France**.



► **CPD:**
Moderated a **Guttmacher Institute** side event: “Ending Maternal Mortality by Advancing Comprehensive Sexual & Reproductive Health & Rights.”



► **UNGA:**
Hosted a SheDecides Masterclass with **The Population Council** on Youth SRHR: **“Driving data to action: what the evidence on adolescents, SRHR and the SDGs say”**.



► **ICFP:**
Facilitated a discussion table for **Rutgers She Makes Her Safe Choice report launch**.



► **Financing For Development:**
Moderated “Financing Our Future: The Economic Case for SRHR” joining partners: **The Government of Colombia, Government of Norway, FP2030, Guttmacher Institute, International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), PMNCH, United Nations Foundation, United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), Universal Access Project**.

► 3. Driving Fact-First Narratives and Global Media Reach:

Throughout 2025 we've leveraged our diverse Champion network to **speak out at critical moments**, including on the Global Gag Rule and ODA/USAID cuts.

Achieved 7 high-impact media placements in leading global outlets, including The Guardian, The Telegraph, Time Magazine, and The Independent.




Unified Global Mandate:

Mobilised a joint statement signed by 13 Governments and 25 CSOs to demonstrate undeniable political unity for SRHR as essential to the SDGs.

► 4. Fueling the Movement: Strategic Intelligence and Alignment

We strengthened the movement by **providing essential research, briefings, and creating learning spaces** for our network. This sharpens advocacy, drives evidence-based decision-making, and ensures strategic alignment across our community.



Critical Research:

Published the **Youth SRHR Research Digest** providing essential summaries, key highlights, and recommendations from recent literature on adolescents' and young people's health and wellbeing.



Expert Learning:

Hosted 2 Masterclasses on "Driving Data to Action" (with Population Council) and "Adding it Up" (with Guttmacher Institute) to build technical expertise and understanding.

Awarded Salzburg Global Fellowship:

Abortion Archives selected for Salzburg Global's "Creating Futures: Art of Narrative" Fellowship, convening global storytellers, artists, and leaders to explore how culture shapes democracy and human rights, and how arts can counter disinformation and authoritarianism.



Podcast:

Launched SheDecides new podcast "**Reproductive Resistance**" to explore the intersectional nature of our movement's challenges.

The Abortion Archives:

Launched the Online **Abortion Archives** and activated physical pop-ups of the POWER TO DECIDE Exhibition at CSW and ICFP, using art, photography, and storytelling to connect abortion rights to the broader struggle for gender equality, and to protect movement memory from erasure.

► 6. New Partnerships and Investing in Youth:

Throughout 2025 we have strategically built new partnerships both within and outside the SRHR ecosystem to expand our reach and resilience:



► **Established partnerships outside the echo chamber:** including **Amnesty International**.



► **Supporting GSAD:** Provided strategic support to the **Global Safe Abortion Dialogue (GSAD)** through activations at CSW and the ICFP Pre-Conference.



► **She Makes Her Safe Choice:** SheDecides continues to be a proud partner of the **SheMakesHer Safe Choice programme**, led by Rutgers, working to advance safe abortion across West Africa.



► **Investing in Youth:** Worked with the SheDecides **Youth Advisory Panel** to ensure youth voices drive our advocacy and strategy.
